



# What does Article 1 say?

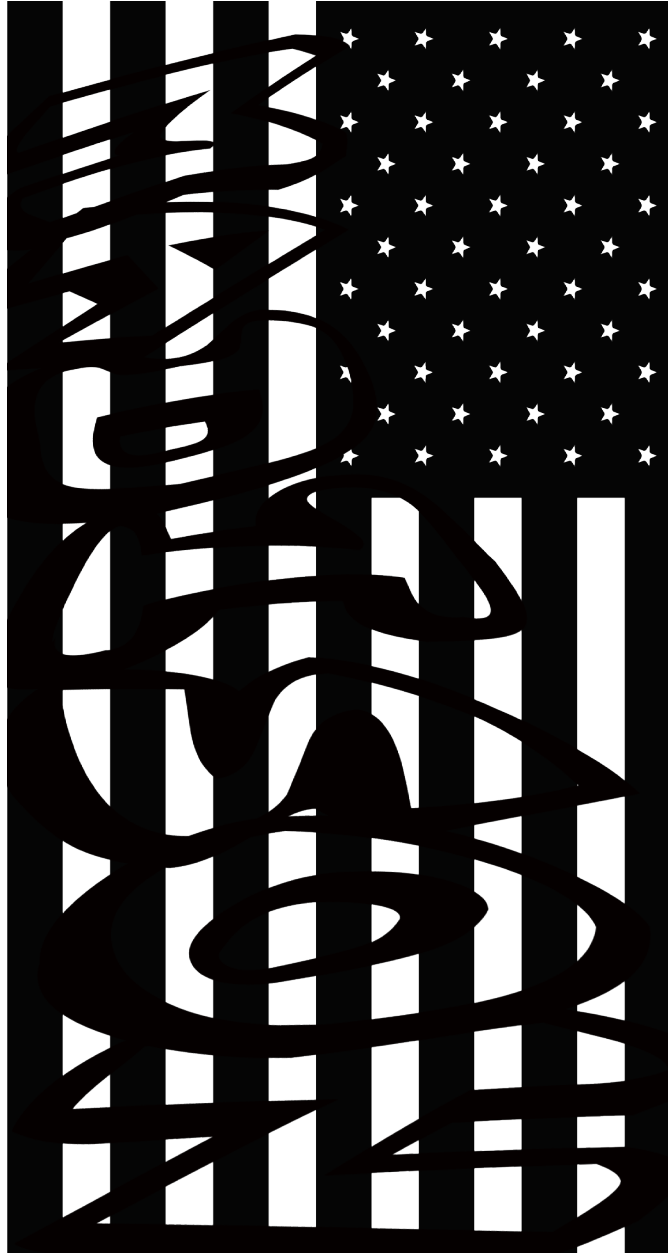


You have decided to run for Representative of your home district. Use posterboard and design a campaign poster encouraging people of your district to vote for you. Be sure to include:
