John Witherspoon (signer of the Declaration of Independence, Ratifier of the U.S. Constitution, President of Princeton) preached salvation to his students and all others who listened. In his sermon "The Absolute Necessity of Salvation through Jesus Christ" given in 1758, he said:

I shall now conclude my discourse by preaching this Savior to all who hear me, and entreating you in the most earnest manner to believe in Jesus Christ; for "there is no salvation in any other." [Acts 4:12]

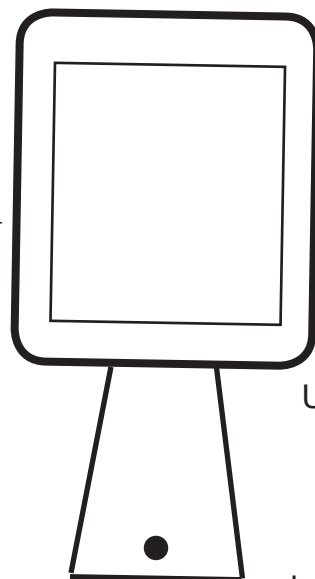
